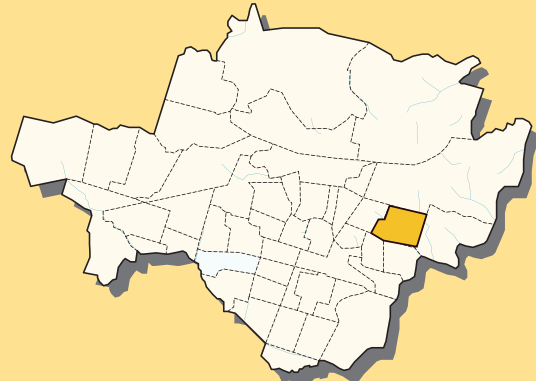


JAGALAN ATLAS

Jagalan's Location in Solo

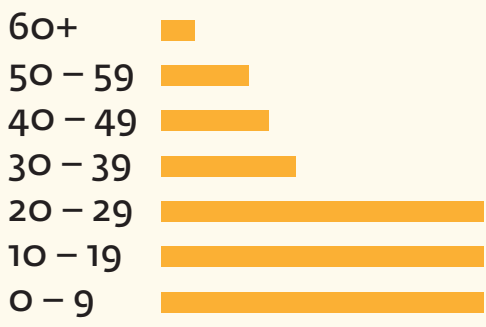

- ✓ Flooding during rainy season

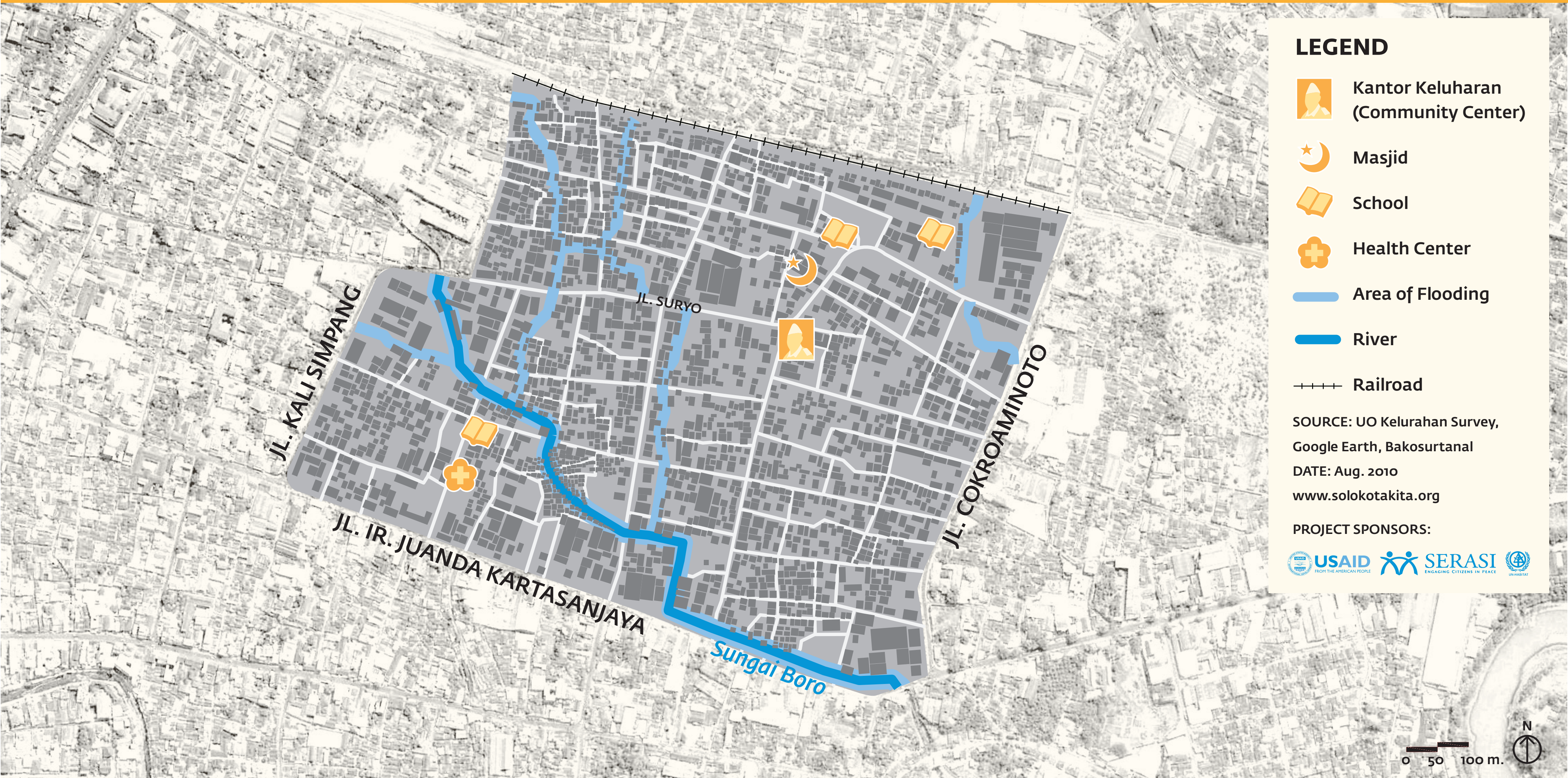


Children Playing Music in the Street

Jagalan contains many commercial enterprises and is close to large markets. Despite these assets, there is a concern about low employment opportunities.



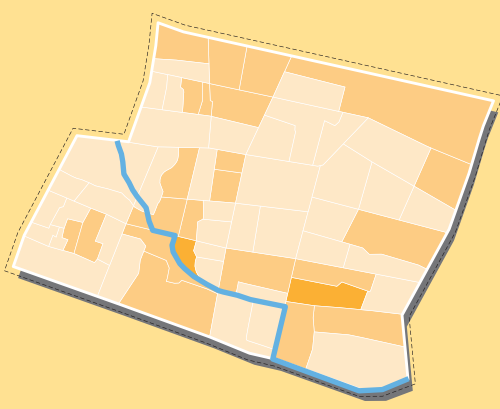
JAGALAN NEIGHBORHOOD MAP

What does the community need to increase access to education? There are 210 children out of school. This is above the Kec. average of 6%. Absenteeism is common in settlements that lie along the railroad and river.

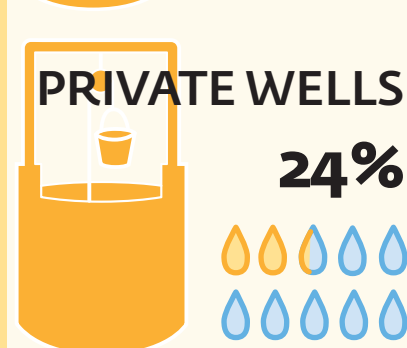
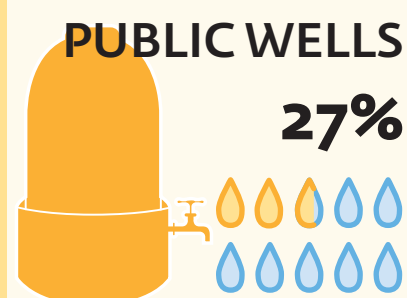
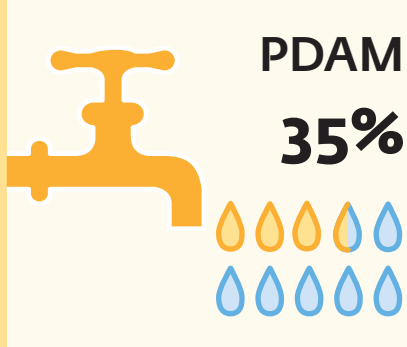

% AGE 7 - 18 NOT IN SCHOOL

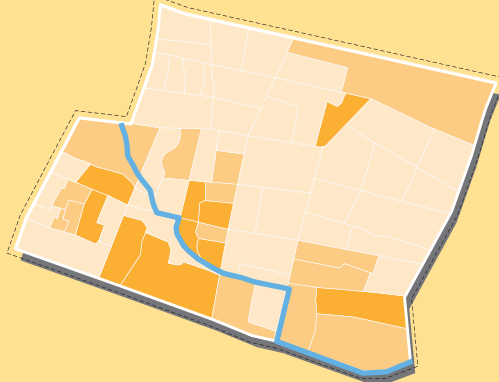

There is a high reliance on wells in Jagalan and low access to PDAM. Residents say water is high quality and safe to drink. Clean water means a that the community will be healthier.

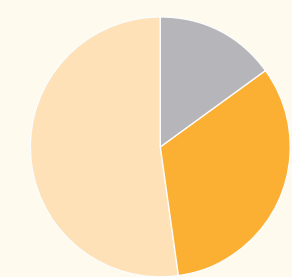


% HOUSEHOLDS WITH PUBLIC WELLS

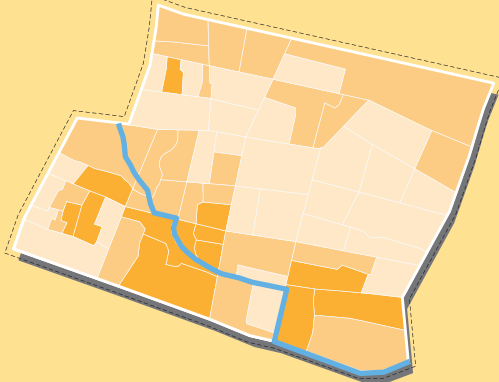
PUBLIC versus PRIVATE WC

% HOUSEHOLDS WITH PUBLIC WC

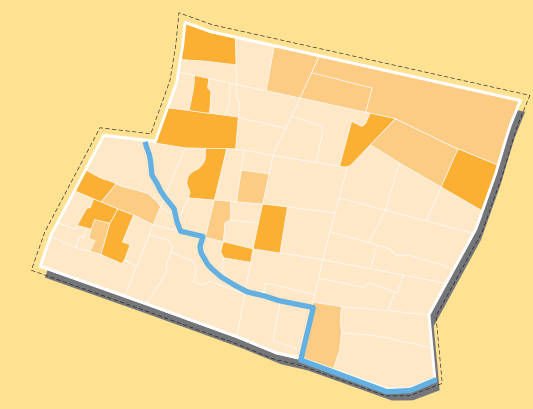

HOUSING

Land tenure is above the Kec. average of 77%. There are isolated areas of low land tenure located in the western and north-eastern area. High land tenure means that the neighborhood is very stable. This is an asset for the community.

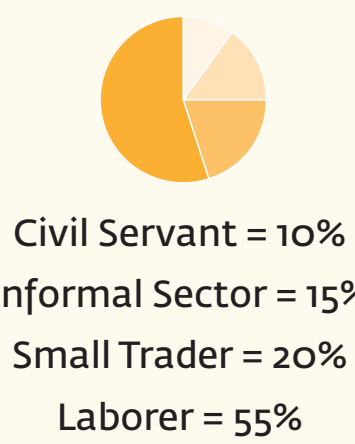


% HH WITH LAND TITLE

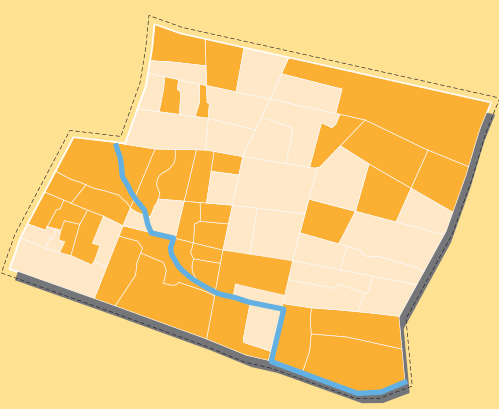


How can the government expand employment opportunities to younger residents in the Kelurahan?
