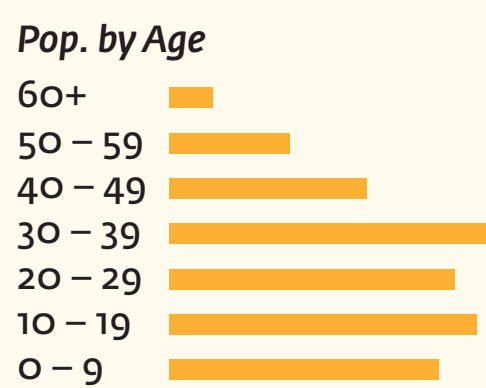


Kampung Baru's Location in Solo

- ✓ Participation in *musrenbang*

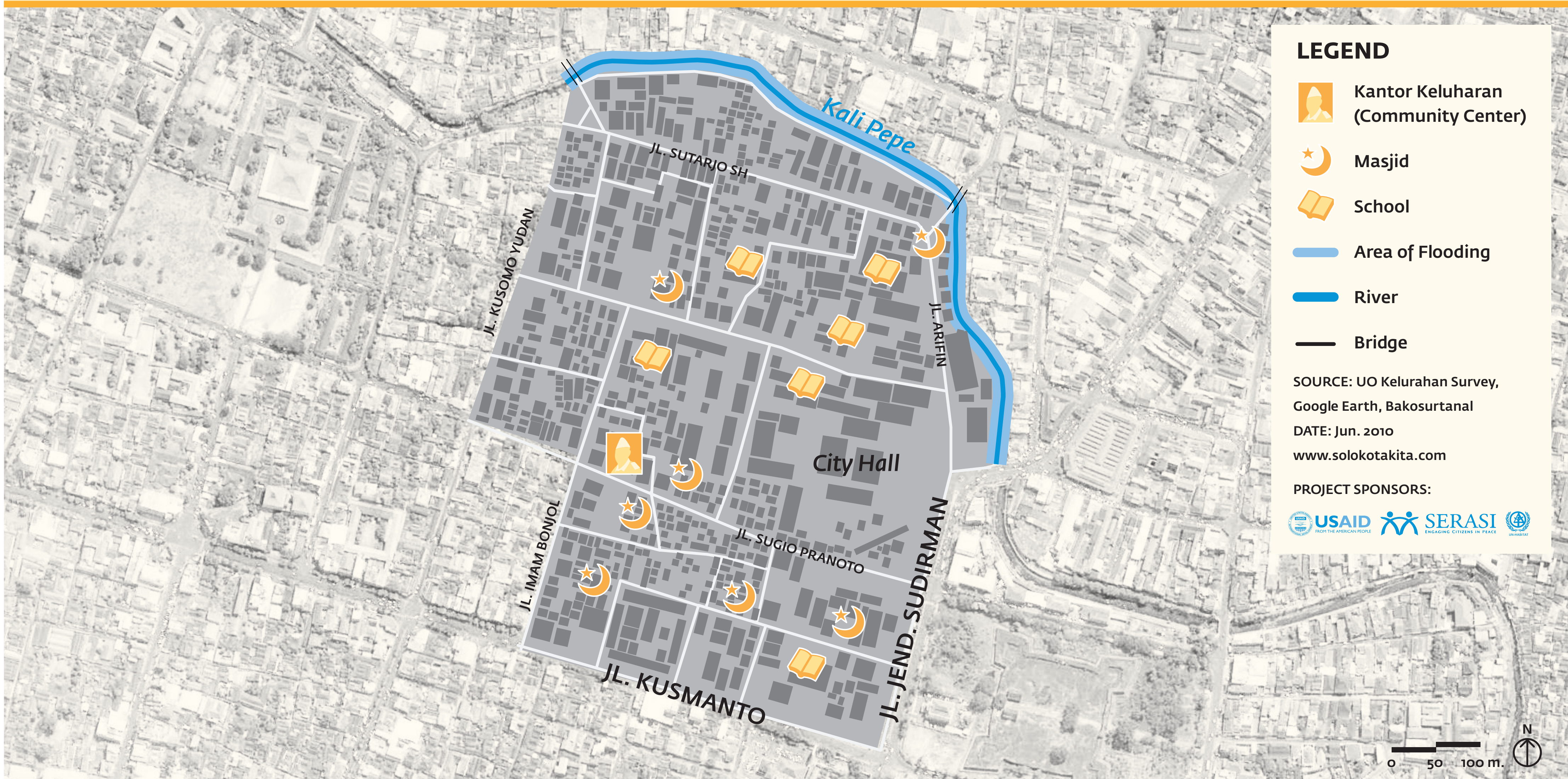


Municipal Facilities in Kampung Baru

KAMPUNG BARU NEIGHBORHOOD MAP



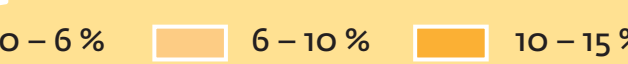
EDUCATION

Out of 365 children of school going age, only 9 are not in school. This is lower than the Kecamatan average of 6%. This means the youth are getting an education. This is an asset for the community. Students come from all over Solo attend schools in Kampung Baru.

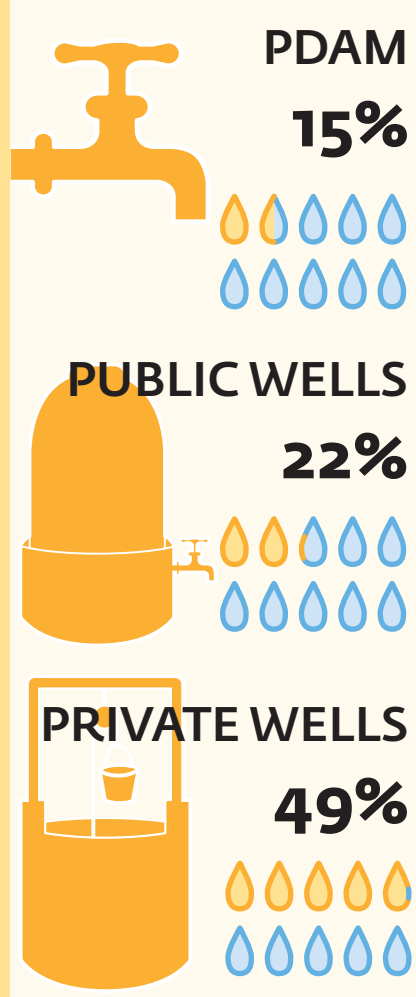
OUT OF SCHOOL 2% of children

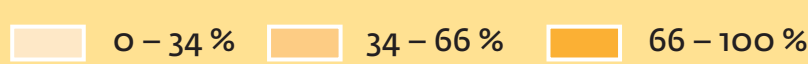


KELURAHAN PDAM

Why are residents unsatisfied with the quality of PDAM water?

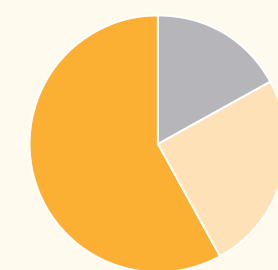
The municipal buildings use PDAM, but residents prefer to use wells. Only 15% of families have PDAM, which is lower than the Kec. average of 34%. Because this is an established Kel., it is difficult to increase PDAM access.

PUBLIC versus PRIVATE WC

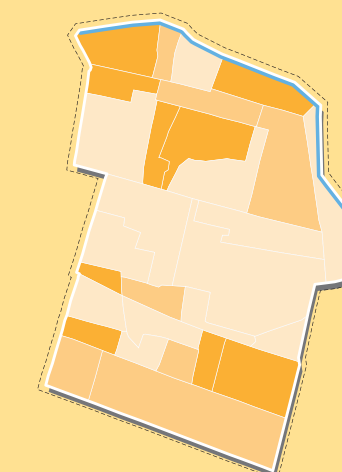


Public = 25%

No Data = 17%

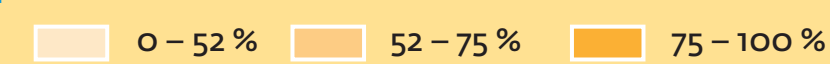
Are facilities adequate for the Kelurahan's role as the center of Solo?

Private WC are used by 58% of families. This is higher than the Kecamatan average of 52%. High private WC reduces health risks.



% HOUSEHOLDS WITH PRIVATE WC



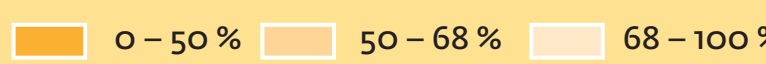
HOUSING

Land tenure is high in Kampung Baru - 80% of families have title to their homes. This is higher than the Kec. average of 68%. This is an asset for the Kelurahan since tenure brings stability to the community. In the center, there are families without tenure who live on land owned by the Balai Kota.

LAND TITLES = 80%

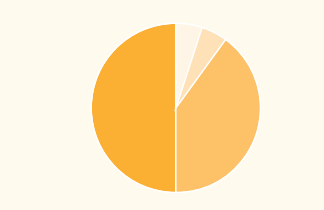


% HH WITH LAND TITLE

TOP 4 OCCUPATIONS



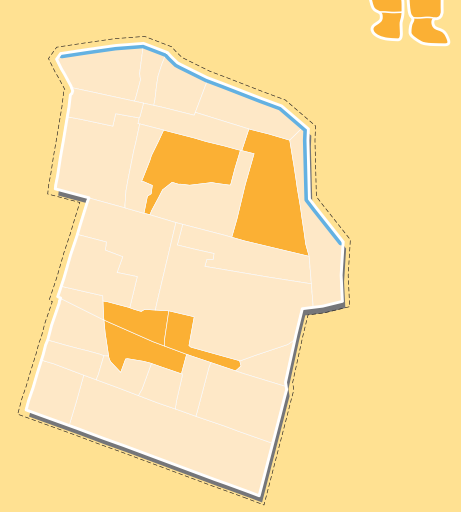
Entrepreneur = 5%
PNS = 5%

Since there are many municipal facilities, activity is highly regulated. So Kampung Baru is not a place where newcomers seek opportunities in the informal sector.

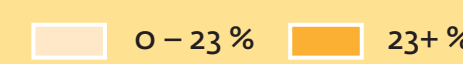
POVERTY RATE = 18%
