What's happening in Kemlayan?

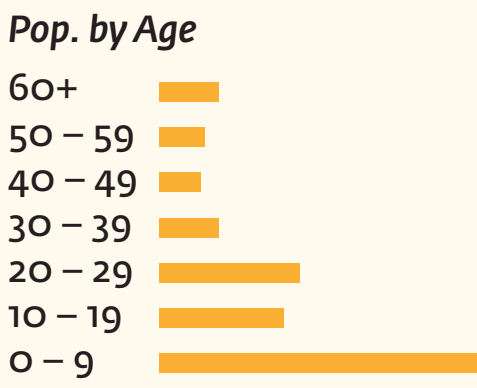

- ✓ Concentrations of poverty in areas with low land tenure

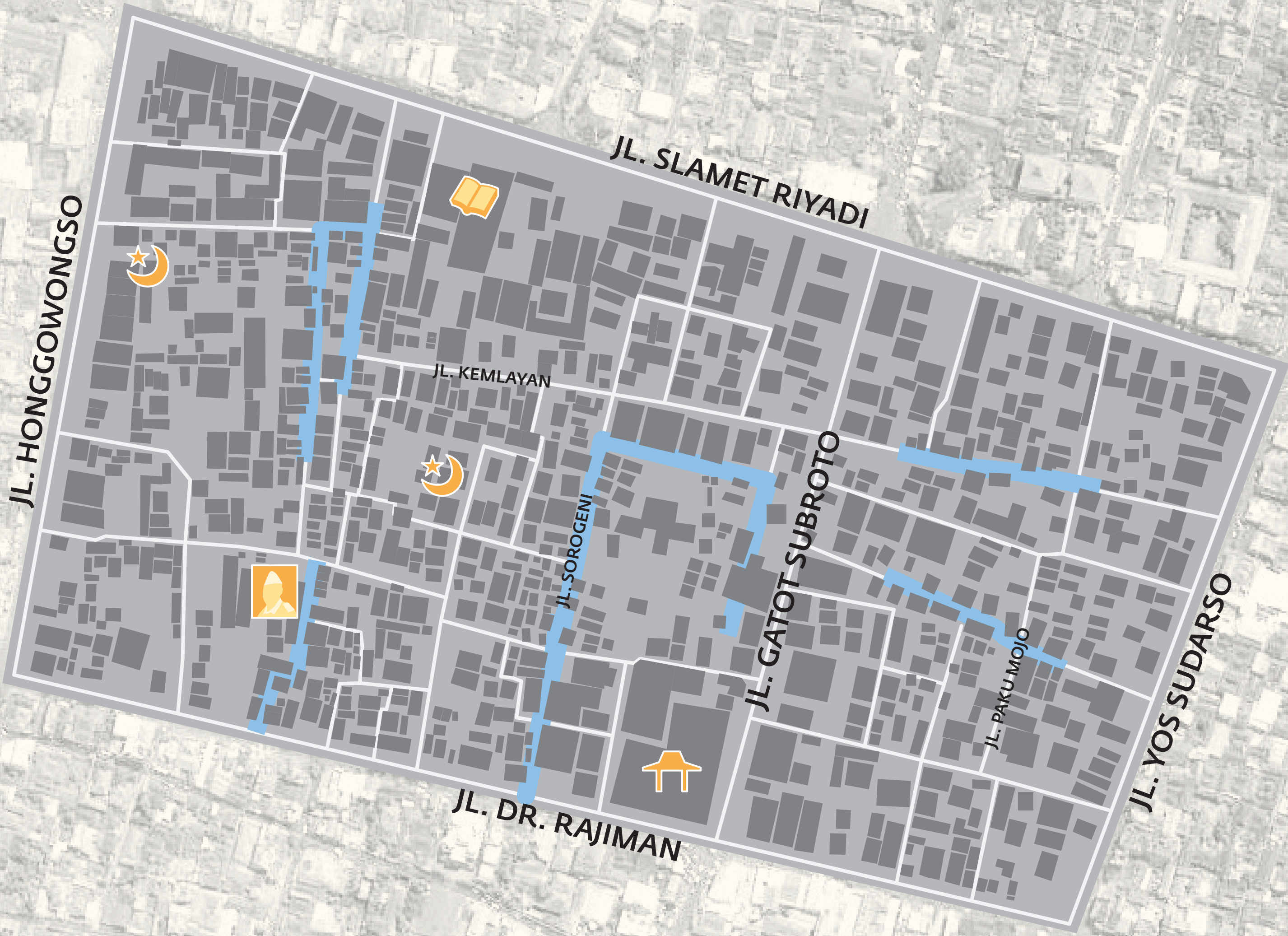


A Public Well in Kemlayan

Health is a significant issue in Kemlayan. There is no health center, so residents leave the Kelurahan for services. Health concerns may also be related to other issues such as poor sanitation and drainage.

EDUCATION

Of 486 school age children, only, only 12 are out of school. This is better than the Kec. average of 4%, so Kemlayan is doing well. The children in Kemlayan are getting an education. In the future they will be a resource for the community.

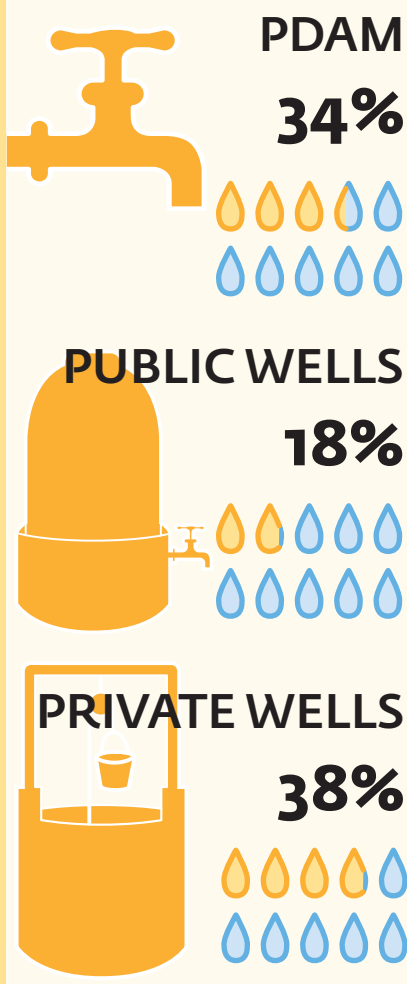
OUT OF SCHOOL 2% of children



% AGE 7 - 18 NOT IN SCHOOL



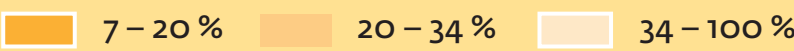

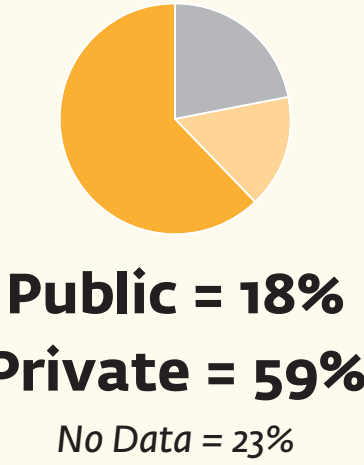
% HOUSEHOLDS WITH PDAM

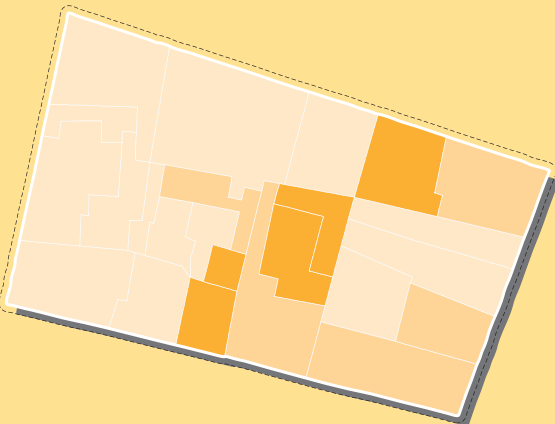

Drainage is an issue in Kemlayan. Many areas flood during the rainy season.

59% of households have access to private sanitation. This is more than the Kecamatan average of 48%.



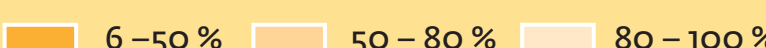
HOUSING

77% of families have land tenure, which is a little below the Kecamatan average of 80%. Land tenure is generally high, but low land tenure in one RT brings the overall average down. This is due to the RT's status as *magersari* land, where titles are not permitted.

LAND TITLES = 77%

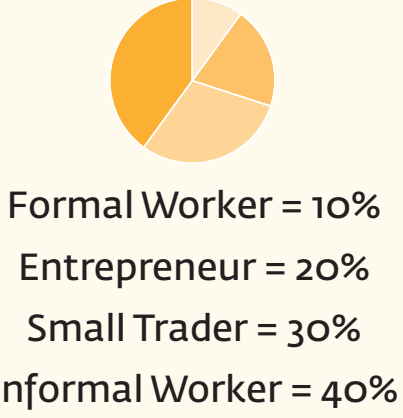


% HH WITH LAND TITLE

TOP 4 OCCUPATIONS

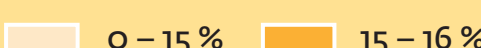


POVERTY RATE = 10%
