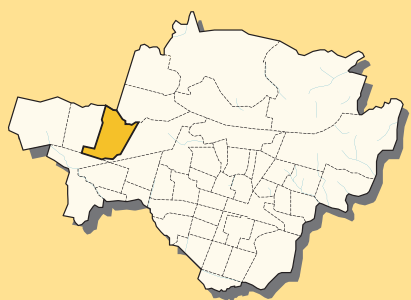

What's happening in Kerten?

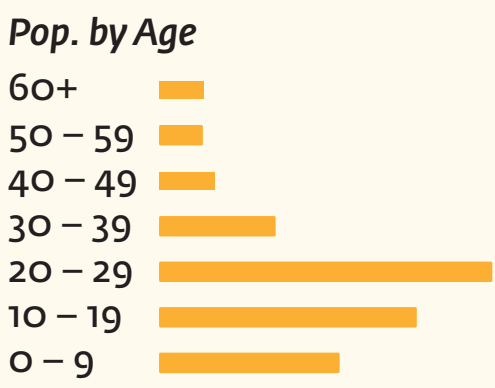

- ✓ Concentrations of poverty

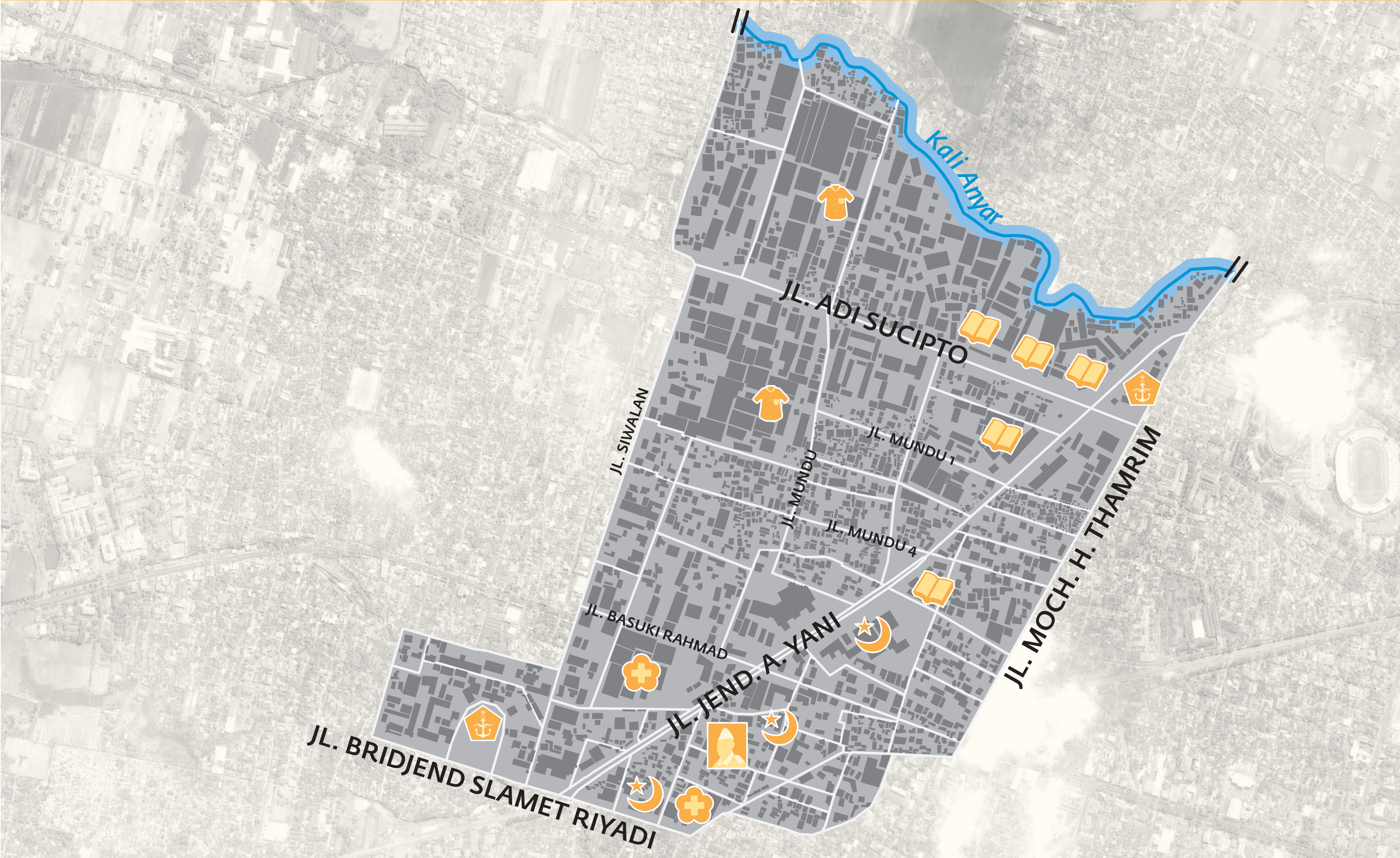


A Typical Residential Street in Kerten

KERTEN NEIGHBORHOOD MAP



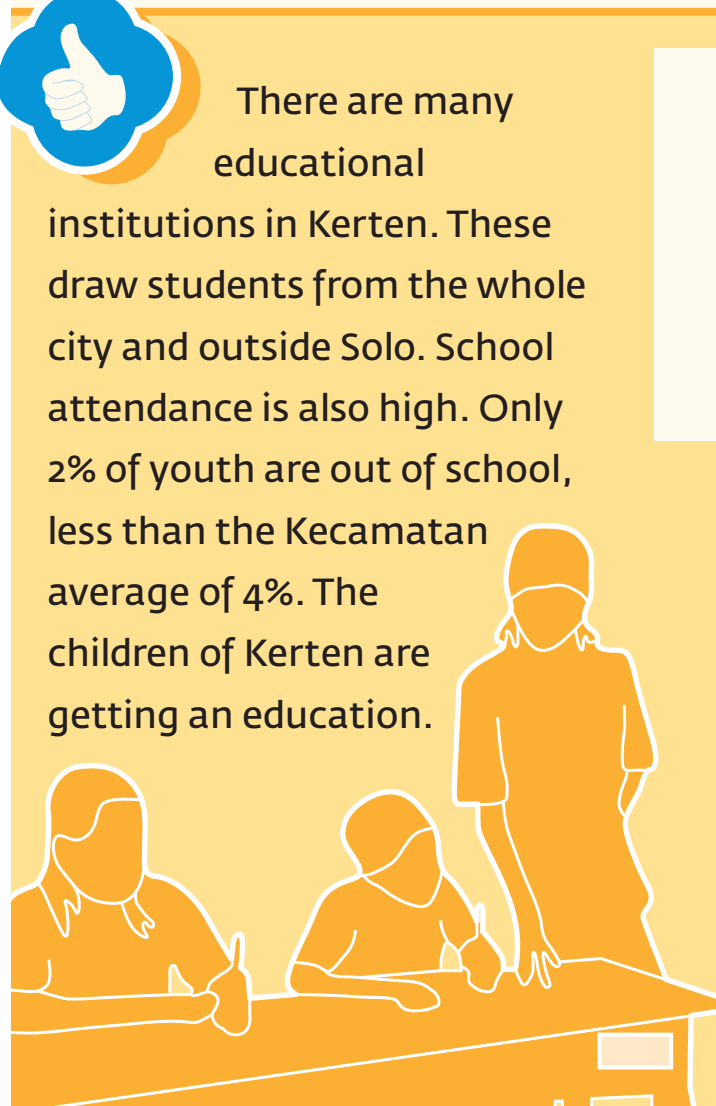

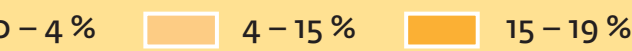

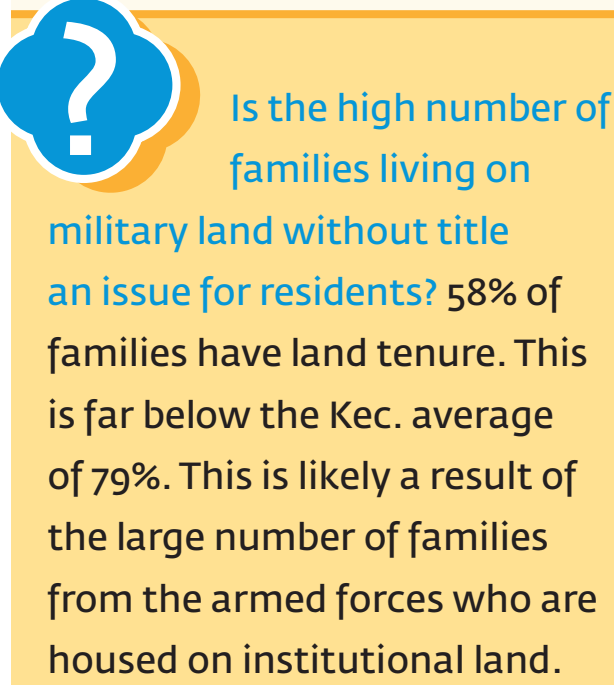

% AGE 7 - 18 NOT IN SCHOOL



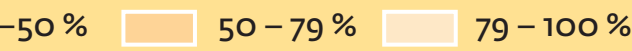

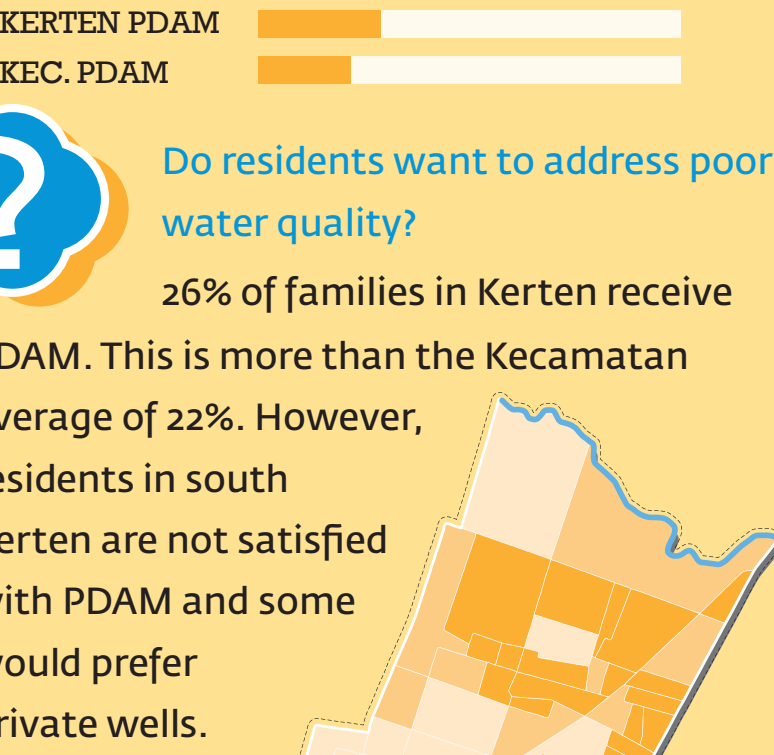
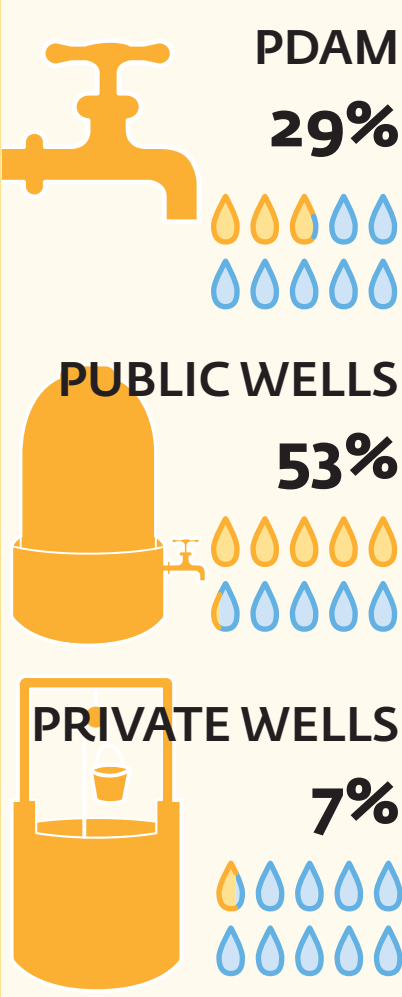

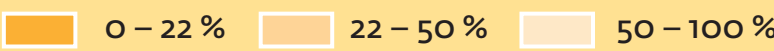
% HH WITH LAND TITLE



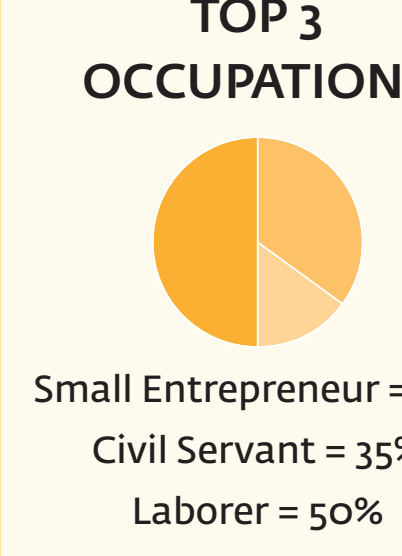

% HOUSEHOLDS WITH PDAM

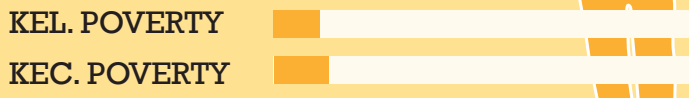


ECONOMY / POVERTY

Poverty is lower than the Kec. rate, which is 13%.



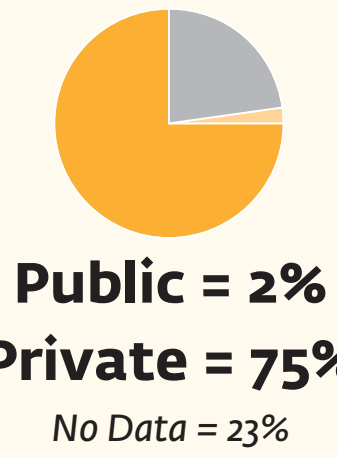
Low-income residents are concentrated in the south and east of Kerten. Residents report low environmental quality in these areas. Both sanitation and housing conditions are poor.

% HOUSEHOLDS IN POVERTY

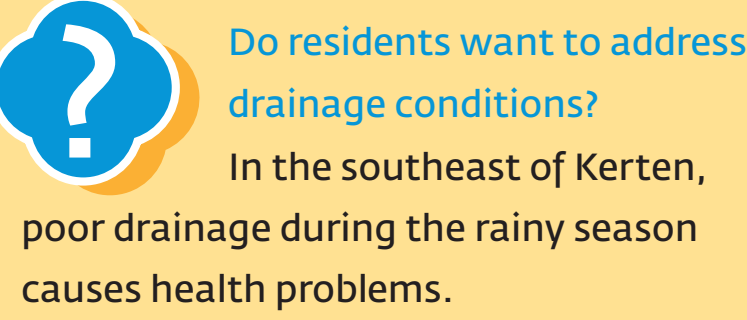


SANITATION

PUBLIC versus PRIVATE WC



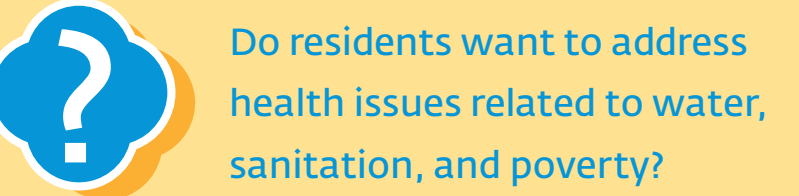
Access to public toilets is very low. Only 2% of households have access to public WC, compared to 11% for the Kec. This is a major issue in the southeast area, where many residents must use public facilities in neighboring Purwosari.
