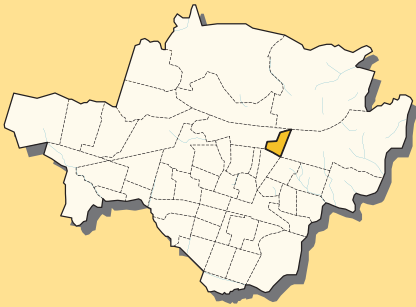


TEGALHARJO ATLAS

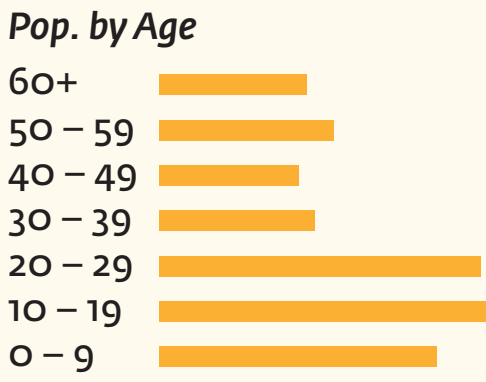


Tegalharjo's Location in Solo

- ✓ Assuring new development benefits all residents

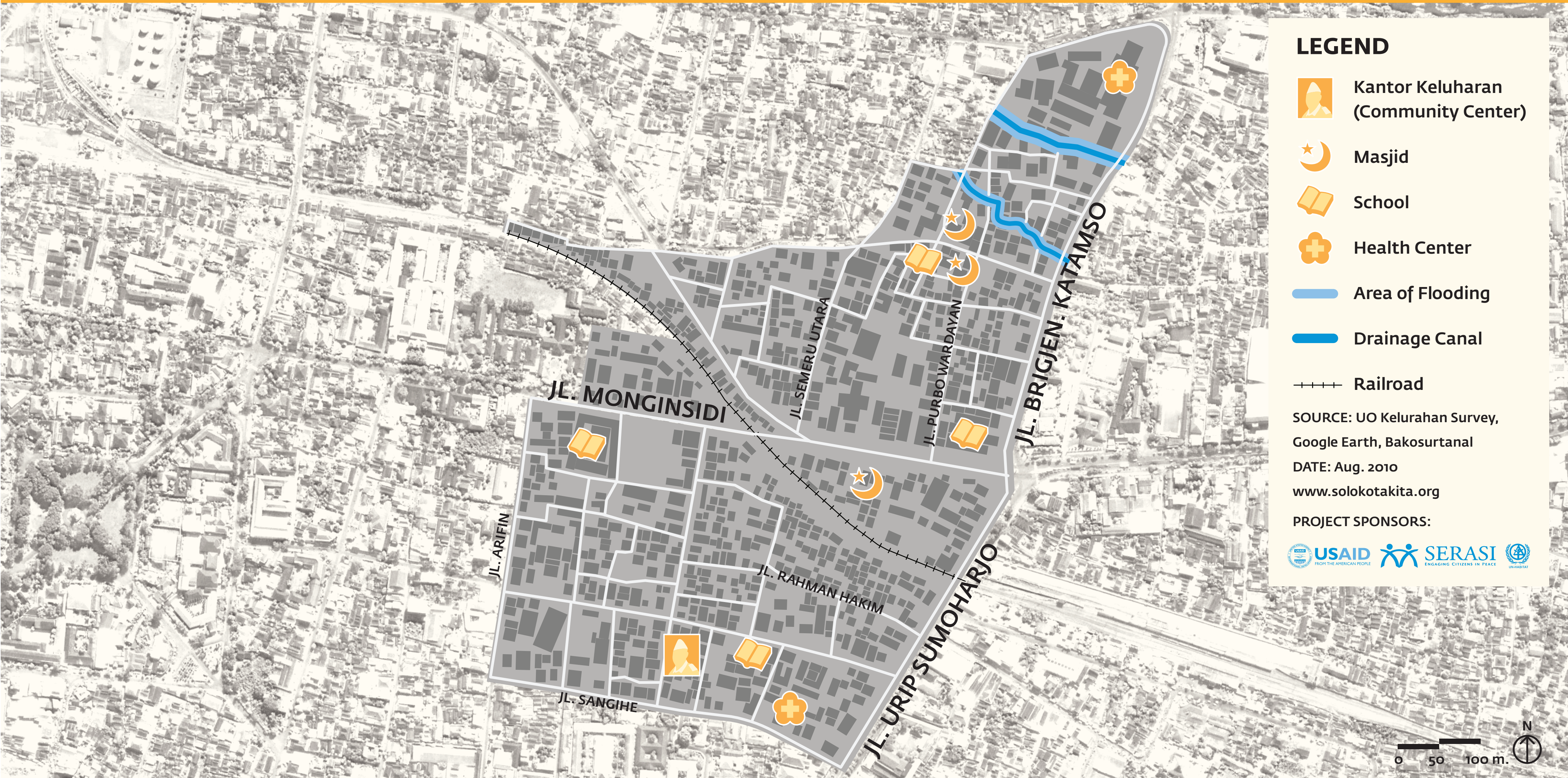


Children after School in Tegalharjo

TEGALHARJO NEIGHBORHOOD MAP



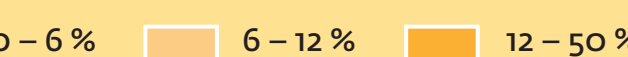
EDUCATION

Out of 703 children of school-going age, only 11 are not in school. This is very low compared to the Kec. average of 7%. This is an asset for Tegalharjo in the future. The children are getting an education.

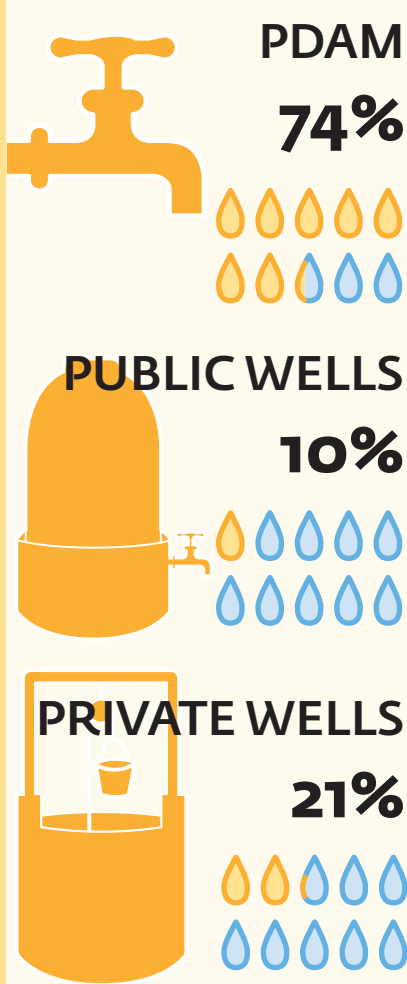
OUT OF SCHOOL

% AGE 7 - 18 NOT IN SCHOOL

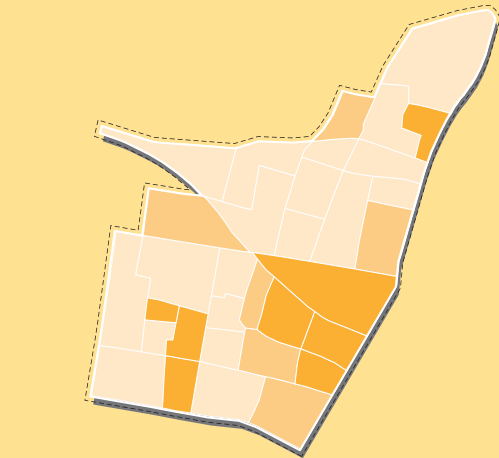

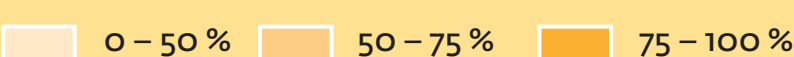


KEL. PRIVATE WELLS

PDAM access is higher than the Kec. average of 50%. Many residents must use PDAM instead of wells because businesses have depleted the groundwater supply.

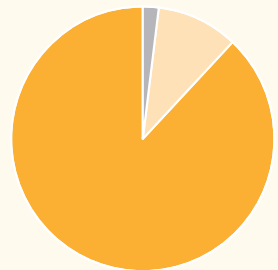


% HOUSEHOLDS WITH PUBLIC WELLS

PUBLIC versus PRIVATE WC

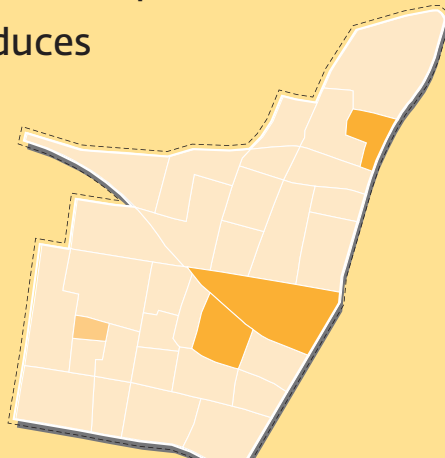


Public = 10%

No Data = 2%

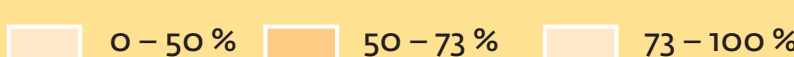

More families in Tegalharjo access WC at home than in the Kec., where the average is 73%. This is an asset since private sanitation reduces health risks.



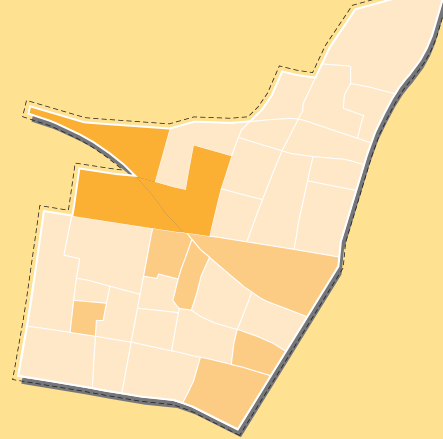
% HOUSEHOLDS WITH PRIVATE WC



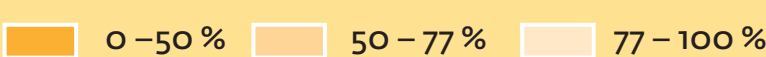
HOUSING

Land tenure is higher than the Kecamatan average, which is 77%. High land tenure is an asset to the community because it means that families are not vulnerable to eviction. However, nearby the railway land tenure is very low.

LAND TITLES = 80%

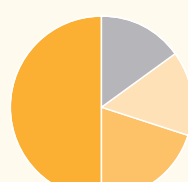


% HH WITH LAND TITLE

Other = 15%

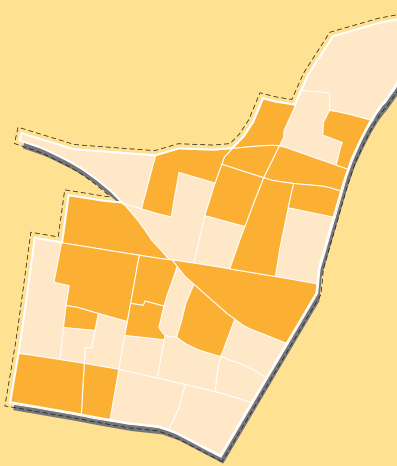


Tegalharjo's location near Pasar Gede market and commercial corridors provides access to job opportunities.

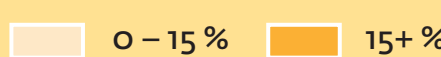
POVERTY RATE = 15%
